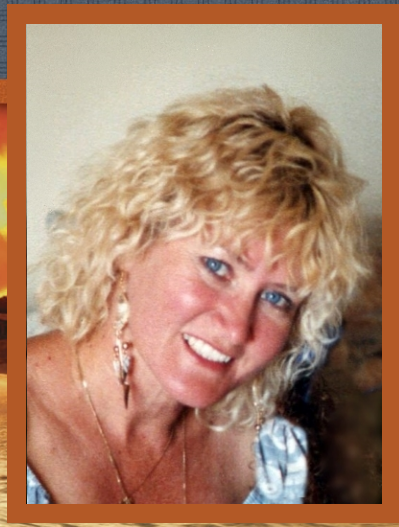


God SAW YOU GETTING TIRED

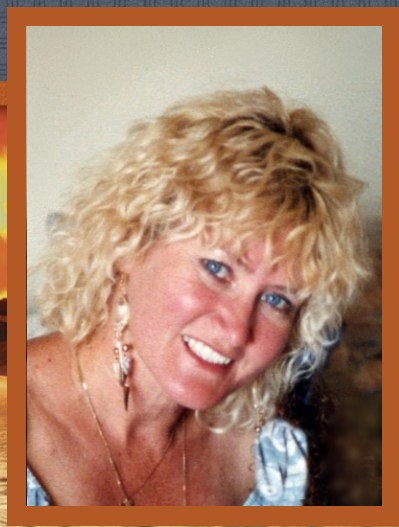
